



Document for Students: Basic Rules for Learning with a Partner or in a Group

Instructions for Teachers:

Below is a document which you can distribute to students, which they can fill out during a group discussion. The goal is to increase their awareness of their personal involvement during group conversations and to think about ways that they could contribute to discussions.

It is helpful to suggest to students to apply **at least three basic rules** throughout their collaborative learning.

The students can also be instructed to appoint one student in the role of “**observer**”, who will record the behaviors of the participants on a correlated chart.

You can also ask students to mark off who is planning to take on each role.

Additionally, you can ask students to write an example for each of the different categories.

It is also helpful to set aside time for reflection at the end of the discussion.

This tool can be used as a component of the reflection process.
