

The Kahoot you have here was made with Kahoot Pro+ and you will find some special features that are less well known in general but help make the game more robust.

Some questions are typical asking respondents to select the correct answer. In some instances, the player is asked to identify what is inaccurate or to put answers in the right order.

On certain occasions the participants must write the answers or choose them through photos. There are times when the correct answer is a number that participants must choose from a numerical scale. In the questions in which you will find videos, the leader must direct participants to start answering only after completing viewing the entire clip.

It should be emphasized with participants that it is essential to take the time to comprehend the questions and not merely rush through for the sake of answering.


After each question or at the end of the game (once the game is over, it is possible to show all the correct answers and what percentage of the participants answered them), it is highly advisable to take the time to delve into each of the questions so that in addition to the excitement of the competition, the content exposed through the game is fully comprehended.

Elaborations on the Questions of the "Leaders of the State of Israel" Kahoot




Ben Gurion made Aliyah in 1906, and on the same day he arrived at the port of Jaffa. He headed to Petah Tikva to start his life there in Eretz Israel as a farmer in the fields of this town.




The decision was very difficult because they knew that if they declared independence, the nascent State of Israel would be invaded by neighboring countries without enough international support for such a decision.


In the early years of Israel, the population doubled, and it was very difficult to receive so many new immigrants. Despite that, the doors of Israel remained open. Israel was accepted as a member of the UN on May 11, 1949. Egypt only signed a peace agreement with Israel in 1979.




He chose the kibbutz Sde Boker because of his love of kibbutz life and to set an example that one should settle the Negev.


On May 14, 1949 (5 lyar) the independence of Israel was declared, and Chaim Weizmann, the first president, assumed office on February 16, 1949 after the law on the functions of the President of Israel was established.



Dr. Chaim Weizmann was a renowned biochemist who helped greatly in critical moments in Great Britain, and thanks to this, he was able to convince the British government to issue the Balfour Declaration. The other events mentioned as possible answers are real events, but it was not specifically Chaim Weizmann who made them happen.

In May 1967, the situation was very tense, and there was an imminent attack threatened by several Arab armies. Faced with this circumstance, a national unity government was formed, comprising 111 of the 120 Knesset members. Moshe Dayan was appointed then as Minister of Defense.




Golda Meir was the only woman to hold the position of Prime Minister.

Going on an operation to Africa to rescue the Air France plane hostages who had been hijacked by terrorists was extremely risky. The chances that the operation would fail were high. Rabin, as prime minister, took the ultimate responsibility for the rescue operation that he approved.


12 - Puzzle

Place the photos in chronological order according to the prime ministers of Israel listed below:






The correct order is:

Naftali Bennett and Yair Lapid in 2021 formed a government where both prime ministers rotated the position.




Photo of Rabbi Lau when he was liberated from the Buchenwald concentration camp by US Armed Forces.


