# **Necessary material**

- A white Canson sheet
- ☐ Yellow, orange and pink chalk
- ☐ A tissue or blotting paper
- Fusain
- ☐ The stencil mentioned in the exhibit



# **Step 1: Observation of the following work**



## A "seniorita", a self-made artist painter

This is an oil painting, acrylic, mixed media, calligraphy.

### Here are a few questions to consider when observing the painting:

- Describe the painting by engaging the child through the following questions:
- What can you see on the picture?
- Which are the colors used on the displayed work?
- Which symbols are represented?



## **Step 2: Creation**

#### - The chalk background

On the white sheet, color from right to left with the yellow chalk, at the top of the Canson sheet. Then, smudge the chalk with a fabric tissue.

Continue the same process with the orange chalk, and then the pink chalk.

After filling the entire white Canson paper, you can move on to the next step using fusain.

#### - Fusain

Below is a tutorial for beginners in order to have a better command of this product:

The next step consists of placing the stencil in the center on the Canson filled with chalk.

Color the letters and the Hanukkah Menorah in Hebrew with the fusain, by spreading it with their finger on rthe different parts of the stencil.

And here is the result:





### - Stencil made by חנוכה שמח :

Using a cutter, empty the letters, the branches and the lights of the Hanukkah Menorah. (See the Exhibit).
