



Information Page for Listening to a Podcast - Socratic Questioning



Think about a topic or question you want to give your students.

Remember - the topic must be about values, dilemmas and basic assumptions.

Socratic Questioning:



Questions of Clarification

Why did you say that? How does it connect to the discussion? What do you mean by that?



Questions to Investigate the Assumption

How did you reach that conclusion? What would happen if.....?



Questions to Investigate Testimonies and Reasons

Ask for an example of the assumption that was raised in the previous question. Just ask why? What supportive evidence do you have for your claims?



Questions of Perspective

Is there another way to look at this? Is there another alternative? What are the strengths and weaknesses of your claim?



Questions that Investigate Implications

What is the significance of this assumption? How does this affect ...?



Questions about the Question

What was the purpose of the question? How does this affect daily life?
