





"I Belong to the Nation" Lesson Plan



Theme: Belonging to the Jewish People – The Circles That Connect Us Objectives:

- Recognize and understand students' sense of belonging in different areas of their lives
- Strengthen their connection to the Jewish people and Israel in the context of Yom HaZikaron and Yom HaAtzmaut
- Use the song "Ani Shayach Le'am" (I Belong to the Nation) by Ishay Ribo as a tool for emotional engagement
- Connect the lesson to the creative project and its symbolic meaning

1. Introduction: My Circles of Belonging

10 min

- · Draw expanding circles on the board, from the personal level to the national level
- Discussion: "Which circle do I feel most connected to?"

2. Song Listening and Discussion

15 min

- Play "Ani Shayach Le'am"
- Discuss significant lines and what they evoke in each student

3. Interactive Activity - "Belonging in Action"

15 min

- Groups receive cards with different scenarios
 (e.g., speaking Hebrew, celebrating Jewish holidays, singing the national anthem)
- Each group ranks the scenarios based on their connection to the Jewish people
- · Compare rankings and discuss factors that strengthen belonging

4. Art - "My Shield of Belonging"

15 min

- Each student writes inside a Star of David how they feel connected to the Jewish people
- · All shields are combined into a collective display

5. Summary
