



Mia Schem Injured

Background:

Mia Schem, 21 years old, a French-Israeli dual national, was one of 105 hostages freed in November after 54 days in captivity. In addition to the psychological trauma that she (and all the hostages) has endured, Mia was shot in the arm and will have a long recovery.

Mia got a new tattoo after her return, explaining on instagram:

"We will never forget 7.10.23. The pain and fear, the difficult images, the friends who will not return and those we must bring back.But we will win. We will dance again! Hamas terrorists want to extinguish our light. But they will never succeed. We will rise from the ashes. We will live. This is the history of our people. The people of Israel live. Am Israel Chai."

Activity Idea:

1- "We will dance again" has become a popular motto in Israel - especially amongst participants in the Nova festival - since October 7th and has been printed on shirts, jewelry, and hats. "We will dance again" is an expression of hope and resilience. Design your own 4-word slogan that would meaningfully express hope and resilience.
