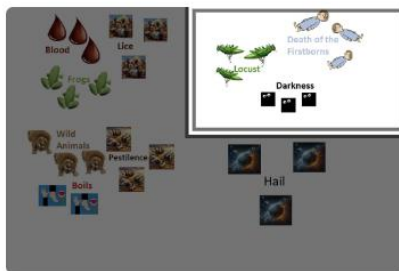

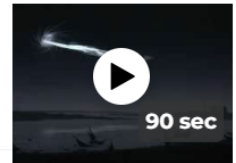

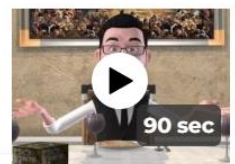

This sandwich is eaten **in memory of Pesach in the Temple as Hillel used to celebrate it.** He would sandwich the Pesach lamb between matza and maror, and eat them all together in order to observe the law:

"You shall eat it (the Pesach sacrifice) on matzot and maror" (Numbers 9:11).
