

# Jewish-Hebrew Calendar Poster

Every Jewish or Hebrew classroom or office can benefit from displaying a full-year calendar to help students remember the names of the Jewish months and holidays and visualize their order during the year.



## Classroom posters:

## Active Learning Suggestions

To encourage student engagement, here are some questions and activities based on the information displayed on the poster.

1. Every Rosh Chodesh, make sure to mark off the end of one month and the beginning of the new one on your class banner.
2. Using [herbal date convertor](#), help students find their Hebrew birthdate and mark it using a pen, post-its or stickers.
3. Assign each child a month with a name tag and challenge the class to line up standing in the correct order of the months - without talking!
4. Print the names of the months, the names of the holidays, and the icons on different pieces of paper and ask the students to group them correctly.
